...oil serves to keep the skin soft
...and warm, pliable, clean and clear
...or beautiful. Moreover it tends to
...shed water and to keep the skin
...impermeable. It is comparable with
...oil on furniture—brings out the
...natural color. Later the skin oil
...will be discussed further.

There is no difference between
...the skin of blond or brunet, white
...and Negro, white and yellow race,
...Caucasian, Mongolian, Ethiopian
...and Indian, except in the relative
...amount of pigment present in the
...epidermis. For that matter, there
...is no difference whatever between
...the blood of a white person and
...the blood of a member of another
...race—not even science can deter-
...mine whether a given specimen of
...blood comes from a member of a
...given race. Indeed it is impossible
...to distinguish human blood stains
...from stains made by the blood of
...some animals.

Hair and nails must be regarded
...as variations or modifications of
...the skin, and are of the same em-
...bryonic origin or development as
...the epidermis or external horny
...layer of skin. So we shall include
...instructions in care of the hair and
...nails in this course on how to save
...your skin.


